INFORMATION CLAUSE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

- 1. The University of Łódź having its seat in Łódź, ul. Narutowicza 68, 90-136 Łódź, Poland, is the controller of your personal data collected for the purpose of registration related to the YES! Young Explorers Seminar.
- 2. In any case an interested person can contact the Data Protection Officer (DPO) of the University of Lodz at the addres indicated under point 1 above, adding: Inspektor Ochrony Danych UŁ or by e-mail: iod@uni.lodz.pl.
- 3. Personal data will be processed only for the purposes of:
- a. registration of active and passive participation in international academic conference;
- b. handling of the registered participants of academic conference, including communication with participants.
- 4. Personal data will be processed:
- a. under the Article 6.1 e) of the GDPR Regulation i.e. based on the performance of a task carried out in public interest, which is laid down by the Act of 20 July 2018 The Law on Higher Education and Science and is related to the mission of higher education system and science in the field of education, academic activity, citizenship creation, as well as participation in the social development and in building the innovation-based economy;
- b. under the Article 6.1 b) of the GDPR Regulation based on the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract;
- c. under the Article 6.1 c) of the GDPR Regulation i.e. based on the performance of legal obligations of the controller;
- d. under the Article 6.1 a) of the GDPR Regulation i.e. based on the data subject's consent to the processing (in case of consent to the processing of the data subject's image).
- 5. The provision of personal data is freely but necessary to achieve the purposes defined under point 3 above.
- 6. Your personal data will not be shared with other entities, except for the entities entitled to by the law.





- 7. In case of sending the electronic invitations, Your personal data (name, surname, contact information) derive from publicly available sources of information. In case of registration via online registration form Your personal data derive from the content of filled registration form and in case of registration via email, Your personal data derive from email correspondence.
- 8. Your personal data will not be subjected to profiling, neither will any automatized decisions be taken based on those data.
- 9. In case of:
- a. sending the electronic invitation for a conference, Your personal data will be processed throughout the period of time necessary to provide information about academic events organised by UŁ;
- b. participation registration, data will be processed throughout the time necessary for organisation of the conference, communication with You related to the organisation of the event;
- c. data of active conference participants (included i.a. in the academic articles) will be processed perpetually;
- d. Your data processed based on the consent will be processed until the moment of consent withdrawal.
- 10. The data subject has the right to:
- a. request from controller defined under point 1 above access to his/her personal data,
- b. request from controller defined under point 1 above rectification of his/her personal data, to have them removed or limit their processing;
- c. object to his/her personal data processing;
- d. transfer the data in the cases provided for by the law;
- e. withdraw her or his consent at any time (in case of processing his or her personal data based on her or his consent to the processing);
- f. lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority in Poland i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office having its seat in Warsaw, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warszawa, tel. 22 531-03-00.11.
