## Labour Law Reform in Ukraine - Step To or Back the European Community

After an active phase of labour reform in 2019-2020 and failed attempts to push anti-worker and anti-union draft laws, the idea of changing (modernizing, deregulating) labour law remains on the agenda of government officials and other stakeholders during wartime. Indeed, the war in Ukraine revealed the gaps and drawbacks of labour regulations, while simultaneously becoming a momentum for adopting new rules in the labour sphere.

Arguments on "soviet" labour legislation and the necessity to adopt the Law on Labor instead of a comprehensive codified document are the cornerstones of the current reform. Obligations under the EU-Ukraine Association Agreement are one of the main safeguards against adopting regressive laws. But whether lawmakers are ready to comply with the EU standards and want to build an attractive economy for investment and return of Ukrainians to their homes?
